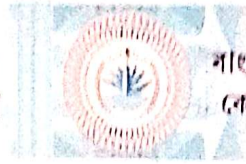
This suit has appeared in the supplementary list as mentioned by
the learned Advocate Mr. Raihan Kawsar, for its urgency.

Upon hearing the submissions of the learned Advocate Mr.
Raihan Kawsar, on behalf of the plaintiff, it appears that the plaintiff has
made out a *prima-facie* case for instituting the instant Admiralty Suit
before this court claiming for realization of unpaid invoice amount
arising out of underwater marine services (cleaning and polishing).

Instant suit be admitted.

Issue usual notices upon all the Defendants fixing the date on
12.07.2026 for appearance by the said defendants and accordingly the
suit be posted in the list for appearance by the defendants on the said
date.

The learned Advocate Mr. Raihan Kawsar also filed an
application for arrest and detention of the defendant No. 1 vessel M.V.



PRINCESS JIA JIA (IMO NO.9189926, Flag: Panama), and submits that the plaintiff, LUFESA DIVER'S S.C.R.L. (hereinafter referred to as the "Service Provider"), pursuant to the instructions and communications received from the owners and managers of the said vessel, provided underwater cleaning and polishing services to M.V. PRINCESS JIA JIA at the Port of Callao, Peru, on 05 July, 2025. The services rendered included Underwater Vertical Sides Cleaning, Flat Bottom Cleaning, and Underwater Propeller Polishing, all of which were performed in strict compliance with the applicable maritime industry standards and practices. He further submits that the defendants, having agreed to the payment terms and conditions, engaged the plaintiff to perform the aforesaid services. In compliance with the defendants' instructions and requests, the plaintiff duly and successfully rendered the required underwater marine services. Upon completion of the work, the Commercial Manager of the vessel, namely Eline Marine JSC, expressly acknowledged receipt and satisfactory completion of the services through email communications.

The learned Advocate next submits that despite the issuance of invoices and repeated requests, reminders, and demands made by the plaintiff to the principal defendants for settlement of the outstanding dues, the defendants have failed, neglected, and/or refused to make payment of the amounts lawfully due and payable under the said invoices. Consequently, the plaintiff's maritime claim remains wholly unsatisfied and outstanding to date.



The learned Advocate further submits that the defendant No. 1 vessel being the foreign vessel and having no asset within the jurisdiction of this court, is now available at Chattogram Port, Chattogram and in order to protect the interest of the plaintiff in the instant suit, an order of arrest of the defendant No. 1 vessel is required to be passed by this court, else the plaintiff will suffer irreparable loss and injury.

I have heard the learned Advocate Mr. Md. Raihan Kawsar, for the plaintiff, perused the materials on record and being satisfied with the submissions as advanced, I am inclined to allow the instant application.

It appears that the plaintiff has made out a *prima-facie* case which established the fact that if the vessel leaves the territorial water of Bangladesh the plaintiff will face irreparable loss and injury. Therefore, to exercise the jurisdiction of this Admiralty Court upon the defendants and for the ends of justice the defendant No. 1 vessel ***M.V. PRINCESS JIA JIA (IMO NO.9189926, Flag: Panama)***, is required to be arrested for the protection of the plaintiff's interest in the suit, since there is no other asset of the defendants available within the jurisdiction of this court.

There is no caveat entered on behalf of the defendants.

Accordingly, the instant application is allowed.

It is hereby ordered that the vessel ***M.V. PRINCESS JIA JIA (IMO NO.9189926, Flag: Panama)***, now lying at Chattogram Port outer anchorage, Chattogram, within the jurisdiction of this court, be arrested by the Marshal of this Admiralty Court and the arrested vessel be kept



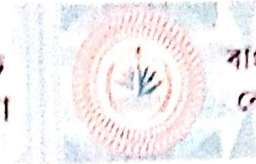
under the safe custody of the Marshal of this Court as security for the payment of any prospective decree until further order.

The Marshal of this court is hereby directed to take the custody of the arrested *M.V. PRINCESS JIA JIA (IMO NO.9189926, Flag: Panama)*, and keep the same under its custody in the condition as it is now and secure its immobility with the help of the pro-forma defendants, till further order of this court.

In the event of satisfying this Court that the Principal Defendants/Opposite Parties are not under obligation to pay the aforesaid claim of the Plaintiffs, or if sufficient and proper security is furnished in favour of the Plaintiff against the claim of the Plaintiff to the satisfaction of this Court, the vessel *M.V. PRINCESS JIA JIA (IMO NO.9189926, Flag: Panama)*, may be released from the order of arrest.

Further, the Pro forma Defendant-Opposite Party No. 7 the Chairman, Chattogram Port Authority, Chattogram, is directed to render help and assistance to the Marshal and his team of this court by providing a speed Boat/tugboat with Pilot on board for the transportation of the marshal and his team to and for the Arrested vessel.

The Superintendent of Police, Chattogram, is also directed to render help and assistance to the marshal and his team of this Court by providing Scot force, comprising one Armed S.I. and two Armed Constable to accompany the Marshal and his team in order to maintain security of the marshal at the time of executing the order of this Court upon the Arrested vessel.



The Pro-forma Defendants i.e. the Harbour Master, Chattogram Port Authority, Chattogram, the Deputy Police Commissioner (Port), CMP, the Commissioner of Customs, Customs House, Chattogram and the Mercantile Marine Department, represented by its Principal Officer, Chattogram, the Zonal Commander (East Zone) Bangladesh Coast Guard, Chattogram, and the Officer-in-Charge, Bandar Police Station, Bandar, Chattogram respectively are hereby alerted and directed to render all necessary assistance to the Marshal of this Court in securing the arrest of the vessel and also to be vigilant that the defendant No. 1 vessel *M.V. PRINCESS JIA JIA* (IMO NO.9189926, Flag: Panama), does not leave the territorial water of Bangladesh till further order of this Court.

Let the order be served by the Marshal of this court, at the cost of the plaintiff-petitioner.
